


IPE

Ipe is the hardest of the tropical hardwoods. It has a natural resistance to decay, marine borers, and insects. It also has a natural resistance to fire with a Class A NFPA fire rating. Extensively used in commercial exterior construction such as boardwalks, piers, and benches, it has become the top choice for residential decks due to its low maintenance, attractive color, very smooth surface and the fact that it lasts over 25 years!



AVAILABILITY

Listed here are standard sizes typically in stock in S4S, E4E style. These are all available with tongue and groove, or groove and groove. Decking clips also available for groove and groove designs.

SPECIFICS

SPANS - At 100 pounds per square foot, a 1x6 will span 24", a 5/4x6 will span 32" and a 2x6 will span 48".

FASTENING - Because Ipe is very hard and dense, boards must be pre-drilled and screwed together. Stainless steel screws and countersinks, or hidden fastener systems are recommended.

FINISHING - Sealers are not required, material left untreated will weather to a nice silvery-gray color. The use of a UV inhibitor will maintain the natural reddish-brown color.

ACCESSORIES - Ipe Plugs, Ipe Clips, Ipe Oil, and ProPlugs.
